Igor was born in Barcelona, Spain. He received his undergraduate education at the Universitat de Barcelona (1999) where he also underwent M.Sc. and Ph.D. studies with Felix Urpi and Pere Romea. A fellowship from Ministerio de Educacion y Ciencia supported three month's research in Professor Erick M. Carreira's laboratories at ETH Zurich, Switzerland.

With a second fellowship he started postdoctoral research in Professor Anthony G. M. Barrett's group at Imperial College London, UK, where he was appointed group leader. In September 2007 he started his independent career as a lecturer in synthetic organic chemistry at Queen Mary University of London, where his research focuses on the development of new synthetic methodologies in organic chemistry.
