Dr. Ford received his degree and PhD from the University of Manchester before being awarded a NATO Post Doctoral Fellowship (1988) which he took to Prof. Steve Ley at Imperial College, London. In 1990 he joined the Biochemical Research Group of Schering Agrochemicals, moving in 1993 to Process Research and Development. In 1996 he transferred to Frankfurt where, several mergers later, he now heads the Frankfurt Process Research Group of Bayer CropScience AG.
