

Horst Puschmann earned his chemistry degree from Oxford University in 1992, later pursuing his Ph.D. at Victoria University of Wellington, where he focused on transition metal chemistry. Subsequently, he joined Durham University, collaborating with Judith Howard and David Parker before dedicating himself entirely to the development of crystallographic software. His involvement in the EPSRC project 'Age Concern' led to the creation of *olex2.refine*, an open-source refinement program based on the *cctbx*. Simultaneously, Puschmann contributed to the development of *Olex2*, a versatile crystallographic tool.

In 2011, Puschmann co-founded OlexSys Ltd. He spearhead the maintenance and development of *Olex2* while offering consultancy services and innovative software solutions in the areas of Chemistry and Chemical Crystallography.
